

Stewardship reflection - June 16, 2019 - The Most Holy Trinity Sunday

"But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth..." (John 16:13)
Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to help us know and live the truth. To prepare ourselves, we need to open our hearts to receive this gift before we can give it. Develop a daily prayer routine. Talk and listen to the Holy Spirit. This is best done in silence, when we can hear His response.

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity (C) - June 16, 2019

In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit ...



I still have many things to say to you (Jn 16:12).
Jesus spoke these words shortly before his passion. Jesus often referred to his Father and said the Holy Spirit would come to guide us ...*into all the truth.*

We have never truly been able to *define* God and the concept of the Trinity: the relationship of three Persons in One. Words do not suffice. Yet God is revealed to us using terms such as Father, Lord, Word, Wisdom, Spirit and many others. Though we call upon God many times throughout our lives, attempts to *define* God are unsuccessful. God is present and yet always beyond our grasp, much like water which we can hold in the palm of our hand, but runs off as soon as we attempt to drink it. We refer to the three Persons as a Community of Love that surrounds us.

When we pray, we make the sign of the cross, a gesture, from top to bottom, from left to right (*Eastern Christians start on the right and finish on the left*). We invoke the three distinct Persons of the Trinity by touching our head, chest, shoulders and heart. We call upon the Three Persons in one God: the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, the Trinity.

We profess our faith when we make the sign of the cross which acknowledges three Persons in the Trinity: *in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.*
