* COVID-19 Restrictions - Code Orange Alert Changes - In effect September 2, 2021



New Code Orange Alert restrictions for all of Manitoba come into effect on September 2nd. Religious services may be held with 50 per cent of capacity or 150 people, whichever is greater. The gathering limit for funerals, weddings, baptisms and prayer vigils for the deceased is 50 people or 50 % of capacity, whichever is greater. Masks are mandatory indoors. We are currently updating our COVID-19 Health Measures and Protocols for Religious Services document, pending further consultation with the Provincial liaison person for communities of

faith. Our document will be published as soon as possible thereafter, and will be available by **clicking here**.
