


* 31st World Day of the Sick – February 11, 2023

Each year on February 11, the Catholic Church marks the World Day of the Sick on the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. This is a time to offer prayers for those who suffer from illness and for their caregivers. Illness is part of our human condition. Yet, if illness is experienced in isolation and abandonment, unaccompanied by care and compassion, it can become inhumane. The theme of this year's 31st World Day of the Sick observance is *"Take care of him: Compassion as a synodal exercise*

of healing", drawn from the Gospel of Luke on the Parable of the Good Samaritan. Pope Francis urges Catholics to heed the example of the Good Samaritan showing compassion and taking care of the sick in a world that discards the most vulnerable. We invite you to promote the <u>Holy Father's message for</u> <u>World Day of the Sick</u> in your organizations, parishes, community, family, and schools. In his message, Pope Francis stresses that "in the midst of illness," the Church becomes a "field hospital" dedicated to "acts of care." No one should be alone in times of illness.
