**Why?** These days are Solemnities and Holydays of obligation in Canada and this year they fall on Saturday. According to the liturgical law, they hold the highest rank of celebration. For this reason we cannot celebrate Sunday mass on Saturday evening. Father Peter will celebrate the English mass at 2:00 pm Sunday, January 2<sup>nd</sup> in St. Claude.

+ Catechism for First Communion in French - Wednesday, December 22 at 7:00 pm.

+ Note – after the 2:30 pm. mass on Wednesdays at the St. Claude Pavilion and the 10:00 am. mass in Haywood on Fridays, Father Peter visits and distributes Holy Communion to the shut-ins. If you wish to receive Holy Communion at home, please contact Father Peter at 204-379-2434 or 204-952-4531.

#### + COVID-19 restrictions:
