*** January 16, 2022 - 2nd Sunday of Ordinary Time**

"To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit." (1 CORINTHIANS 12:7)

*** Seven Week Life in the Spirit Online Seminar – Starts January 23, 2022**

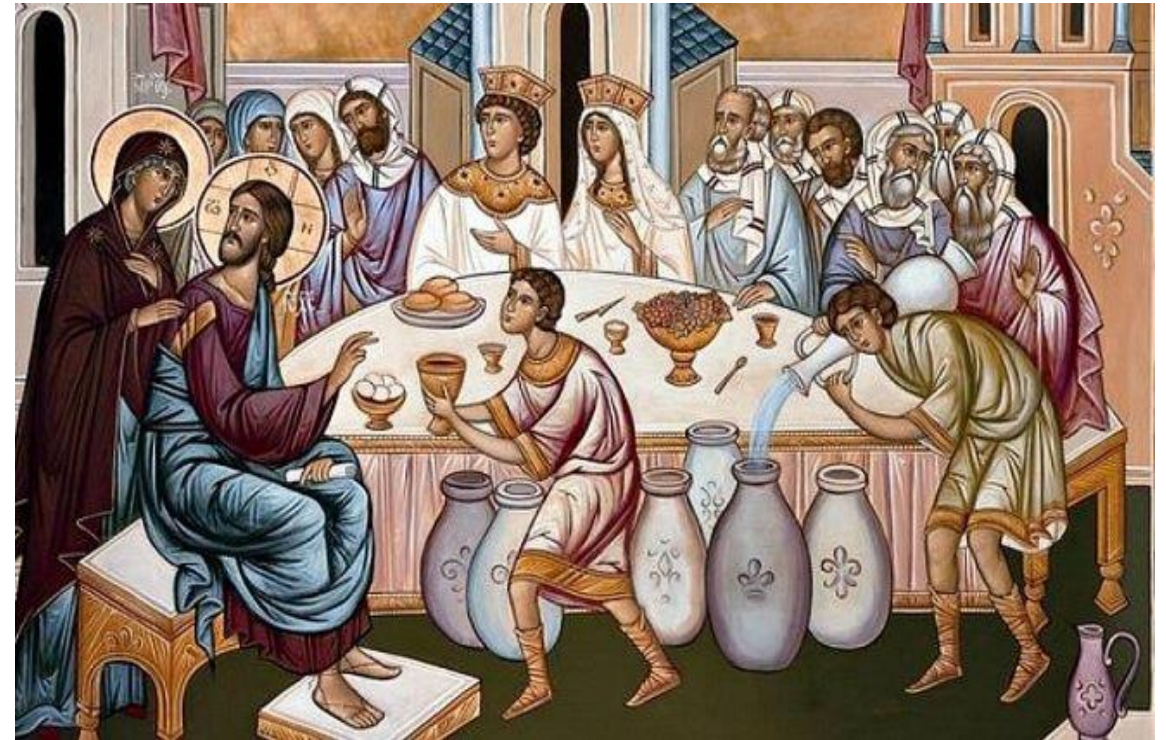

The Wedding at Cana



Some thoughts on today's scripture, John 2.1-12

John's Gospel speaks of Jesus' miracles as 'signs' because they always point to something deeper than the merely miraculous. They inform us about who Jesus is, and about the purpose of his mission. So in the Cana story, for example, Jesus replaces the water prescribed for Jewish purifications with more than one hundred and twenty gallons of wine! According to the Jewish Scriptures, when the Messiah comes there shall be an abundance of new wine, a symbol for God's abundant goodness towards his people. That Jesus turns so much water into the best of wines is a 'sign' that he is in fact the long awaited Messiah. (Source: <https://www.sacredspace.ie/scripture/john-21-11>)
