*** Aid to the Church in Need – One Million Children Praying the Rosary**



Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) Canada is launching the Canadian website for the international campaign "One Million Children Praying the Rosary." ACN invites children, families, schools, parishes, and youth groups across the country to join a great prayer chain for peace on Wednesday, October 7—the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.

"This year, we are asking all the children participating in the event to pray especially for the millions of children directly affected by war," explains Marie-Claude Lalonde, National Director of ACN. "The latest figure from UNICEF is alarming: more than 473 million children live in conflict-affected areas. It is urgent that we hold them in our prayers, including the powerful prayer of the Rosary," she says.

Father Anton Lässer, Ecclesiastical Assistant for ACN International, notes that millions of children are living with the consequences of war. "Fathers and mothers are being killed. Many children can no longer go to school. Family homes are being destroyed. They have lost their homelands and cannot return."

Dear Parishioners,

We hope that all have had a pleasant summer and that the harvests are bountiful. We take this opportunity to thank you all for supporting your parish through your donations. The Sunday donations to the end of August were almost even with last year.

The insurance invoice for last year \$5200.00 and covers October 1st to September 30th so is due shortly. Our Spring Bazaar raised \$2398.32, the September 6th blue envelopes yielded \$1160.00 to date, leaving us well short of our goal.

We welcome any help our parishioners can give to meet this expense. Your donations are non-taxable to the diocese, which means that all the money received stays in the parish and a tax receipt is issued at the end of the year.

Donations should be made payable to "St. Denis Parish" and mark on your envelope "Insurance Donation" and write your envelope number on the envelope or use the blue envelope provided at the beginning of September. Please include your name and address if you do not have an envelope number. Deposit your donation in the Sunday collection basket between now and the end of the year or hand it in to one of the trustees.

Please **don't** wait until the last day of the year. You risk missing the deadline for the year.
