

And, while social media's speed and reach exponentially increase the potential good it can do, they also increase the potential harm it can do. We are impacted by the role it plays in the spread of misinformation, the coarsening of civil discourse, the radicalization of political systems, and the mental health crisis that is especially prevalent among our youth. As such, social media is worthy of individual Catholics's attention, as well as that of our parishes and dioceses, who quite often avail themselves of these tools.
