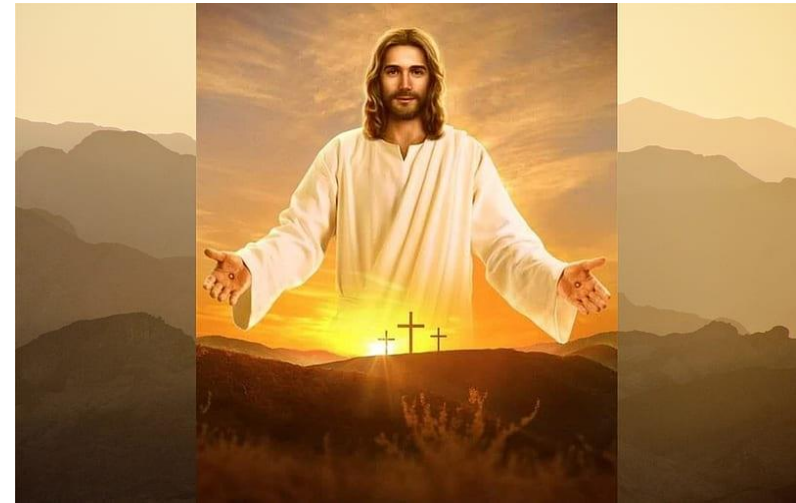

Easter Message 2024

Dear friends, brothers and sisters in Christ,

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that **“the Resurrection of Jesus is the crowning truth of our faith in Christ, a faith believed and lived as the central truth by the first Christian community; handed on as fundamental by Tradition; established by the documents of the New Testament; and preached as an essential part of the Paschal mystery along with the cross: Christ is risen from the dead! Dying, he conquered death; to the dead, he has given life (CC # 638).** Easter is a “source of light,” which fills us “with its brilliance.” Therefore Easter is not simply one feast among others, but the “Feast of feasts”, the “Solemnity of solemnities”. ***“This is the day that the Lord has made; Let us rejoice and be glad in it”*** (Ps 117, 24).

Celebrating the joy of Easter, we are invited to follow Jesus more closely and faithfully, as He reveals to us: ***“I am Light of the world, whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life.”*** (John 8.12). Therefore, brothers and sisters, walk always in the light of Christ! By the grace of the Risen Lord, may we, as disciples of Christ, become the witnesses to the joy of the Resurrection, and through our actions and our words, radiate the light of Easter within our families, our communities and our workplaces.

May the Lord fill your heart with love, joy and inner peace!
Alleluia. Alleluia. Happy Easter to you and your family.
