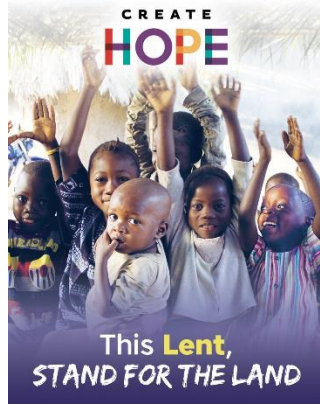

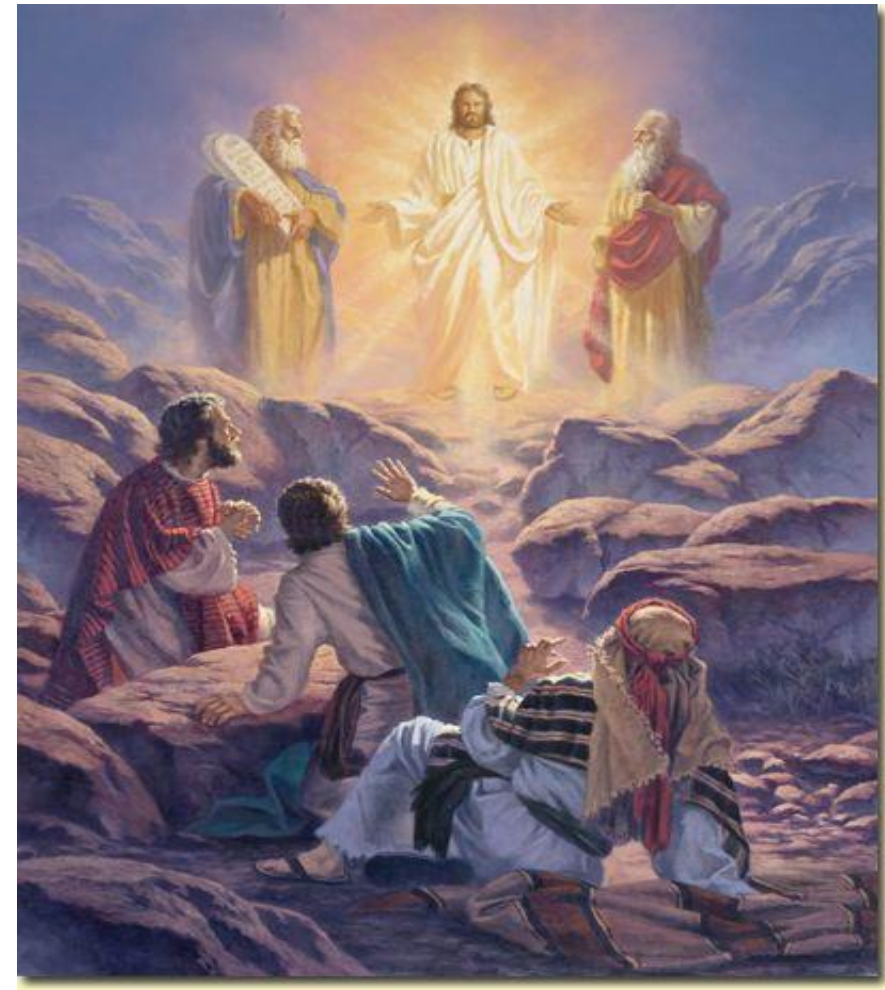
REMINDER Donate today! - Support for Syria and Turkey
