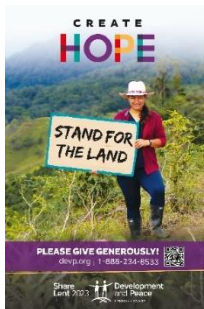
On March 13, the Holy Father reiterated his wish for peace in the world, and his dream for the Church and the world; "fraternity, tears and smiles".

"Human brotherhood, we are all brothers. Learn not to be afraid to cry and smile. When a person knows how to cry and smile, it is a person who has his feet on the ground and his eyes on the horizon of the future. If you forget to cry, something is wrong. And if you forget to smile, it's even worse."
