*** Take a year to take your faith to the next level!**

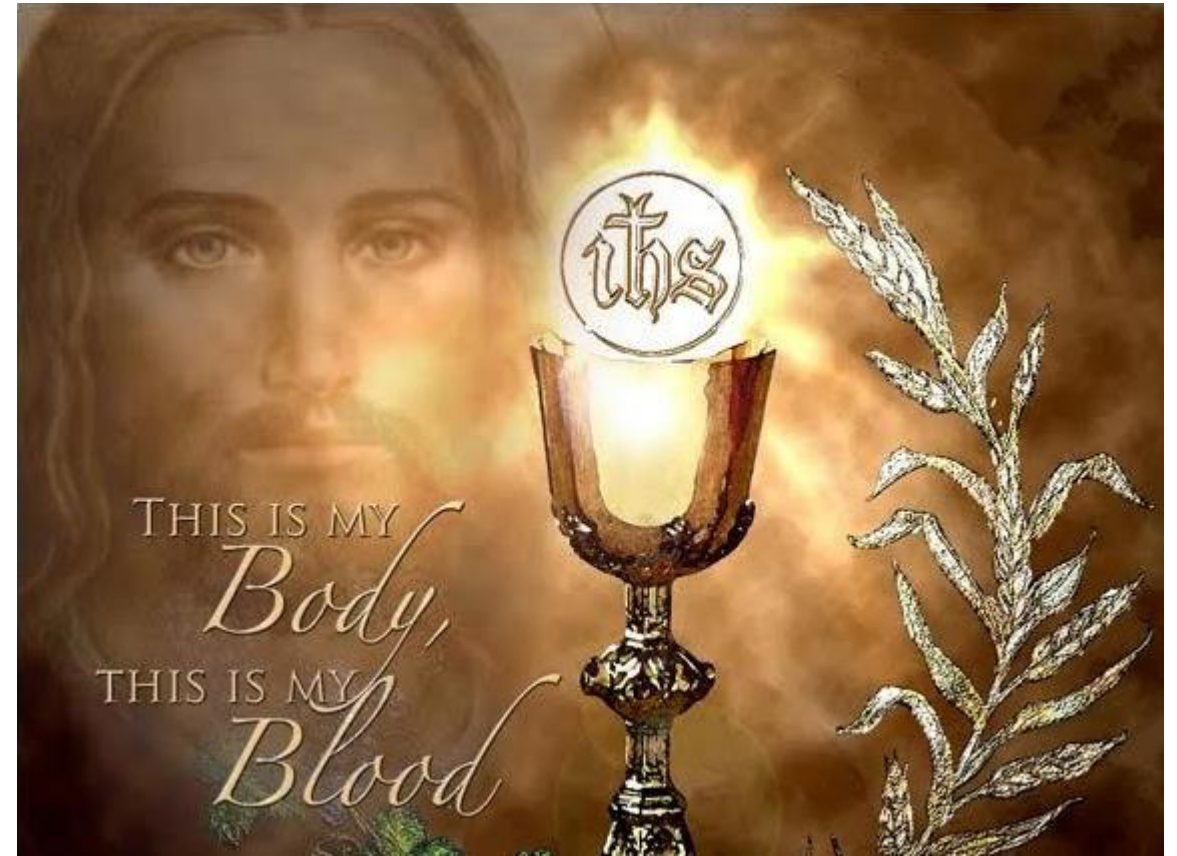
