October 1, the feast of Saint Thérèse of Lisieux, patroness of missions, marked the beginning of Missionary Month. World Mission Day (WMD), the “summit” of Missionary Month, will be celebrated on **October 22** and will once again be an opportunity to support projects and initiatives in several of the approximately 1,100 poorest dioceses in the world which still depend of the Dicastery for Evangelization. Inspired by the story of the

disciples of Emmaus, this year’s theme is: “Hearts on fire, feet on the move. » (cf. Luke 24, 13-35)

In his Message published on January 6, 2023, Pope Francis once again recalls the permanent validity of the missio ad gentes, the mission to all peoples, given to the Church by the Risen Lord, to evangelize every person and every people until 'to the ends of the Earth.

*** \$500,000 for a second aid package for regions in Syria affected by earthquake**

International Pontifical Charity Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) has approved a second aid package of nearly half a million dollars to help the local Church recover from the [devastating February earthquake](#).

The money sent to Syria will help restore critical Church infrastructures and continue to provide aid to those in need. ACN was one of the first international organizations to offer emergency aid in Syria after the earthquake, thanks to its established presence on the ground and local trusted partners. The Catholic charity provided material, psychological, and educational assistance. The new aid

package will go towards preserving and restoring crucial Church infrastructure, directly benefitting around 30,000 people from eight different rites in the four governorates most affected by the earthquake. For more information or to donate, [click here](#)

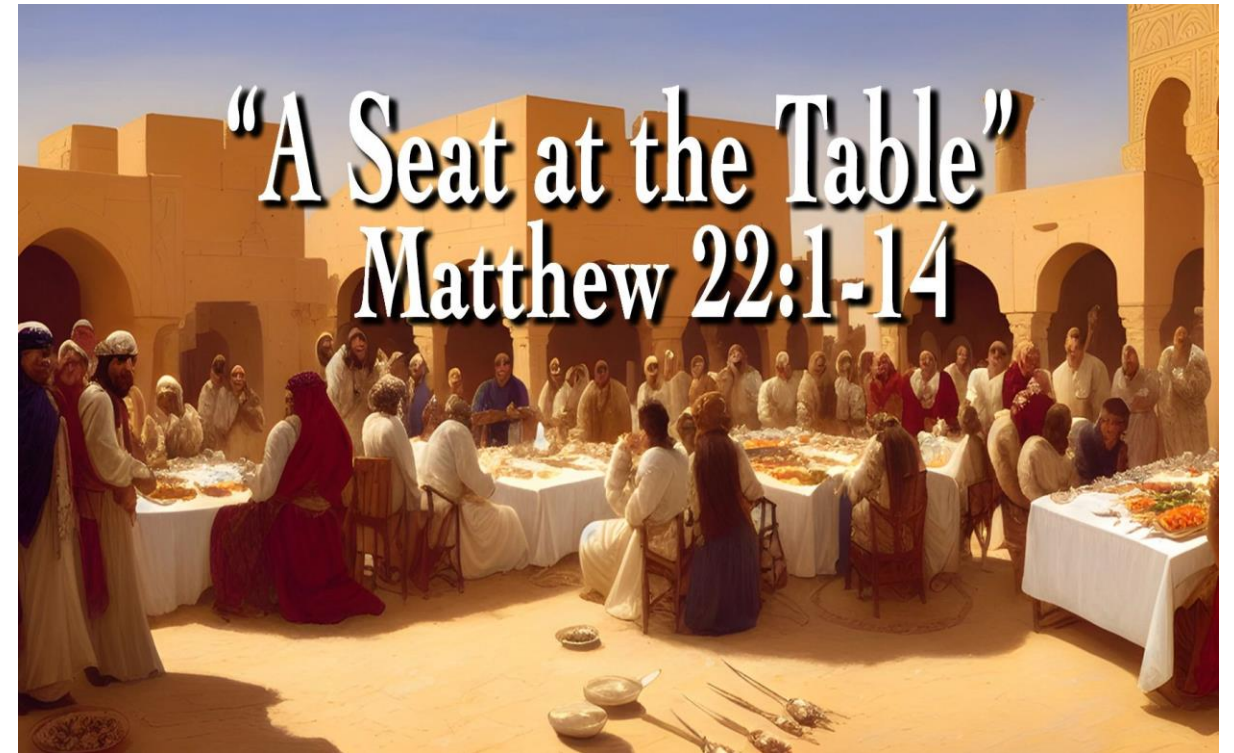
