The Catechism teaches: “All who die in God’s grace and friendship but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death, they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven.” (CCC 1030) For this reason, the Church always urges us to pray for those who have gone before us.

Some practical and feasible suggestions: **We take time to visit cemeteries and pray for all souls. Request and offer Mass Intentions to pray for the repose of souls of all the faithful departed. November is an ideal time for us to help the Holy Souls through prayer and acts of love and charity.**
