### \* **What is Holistic Sexuality? – March 15 & 29, and April 9, May 3, 17 & 31, 2026**

This course examines the experience of sexuality through the lens of Church teaching. It helps young adults come to terms with their sexuality and fertility and assists them in making responsible decisions. Beginning with the physical and practical, the young person can then integrate the intellectual, emotional, social, and spiritual aspects of their person and mature into a fully integrated human being.

For young adults 18 to 35, but all adults are welcome.

For men and women: sessions are presented separately for both men and women.

For Catholics: open to all, this course is rooted in Catholic teaching and wisdom.

WHEN: 2:30 PM to 4:30 PM on Sundays (March 15 & 29, April 19, and May 3, 17 & 31)
