## \* Marriage Enrichment Retreat 1 & 2 — May 2 to 3, 2026

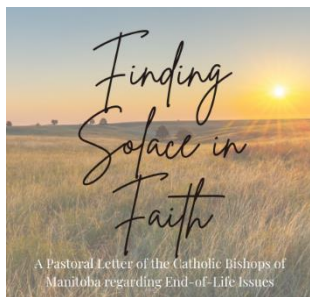
