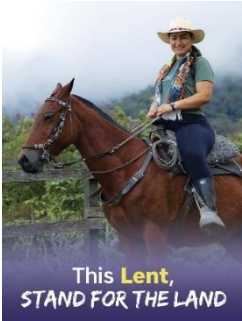

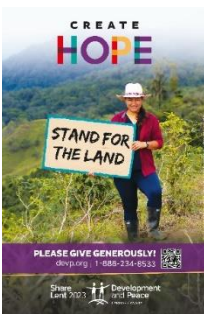
### + Development and Peace: Colombia: defence of land and territory
