*** Forgive Us Our Debts – Pastoral Letter on Debt Forgiveness in the Jubilee Year 2025**

Twenty-five years ago, hundreds of thousands of Canadians responded to the spirit of the Jubilee Year by signing a global petition calling for the cancellation of the debts of the poorest countries. With the support of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops and many ecumenical partners, Jubilee 2000 is remembered as one of the most successful faith-based campaigns in Canadian history. Working with partners around the world, and encouraged by Pope Saint John Paul II's call for debt justice, these efforts helped cancel over \$100 billion in debt for more than 30 countries, including a great deal of Canada's bilateral debt.
