The snow will soon be gone, and summer will be here quickly! Registrations for our summer camp program are open now. Register before June 1st to get the \$50 early bird discount!

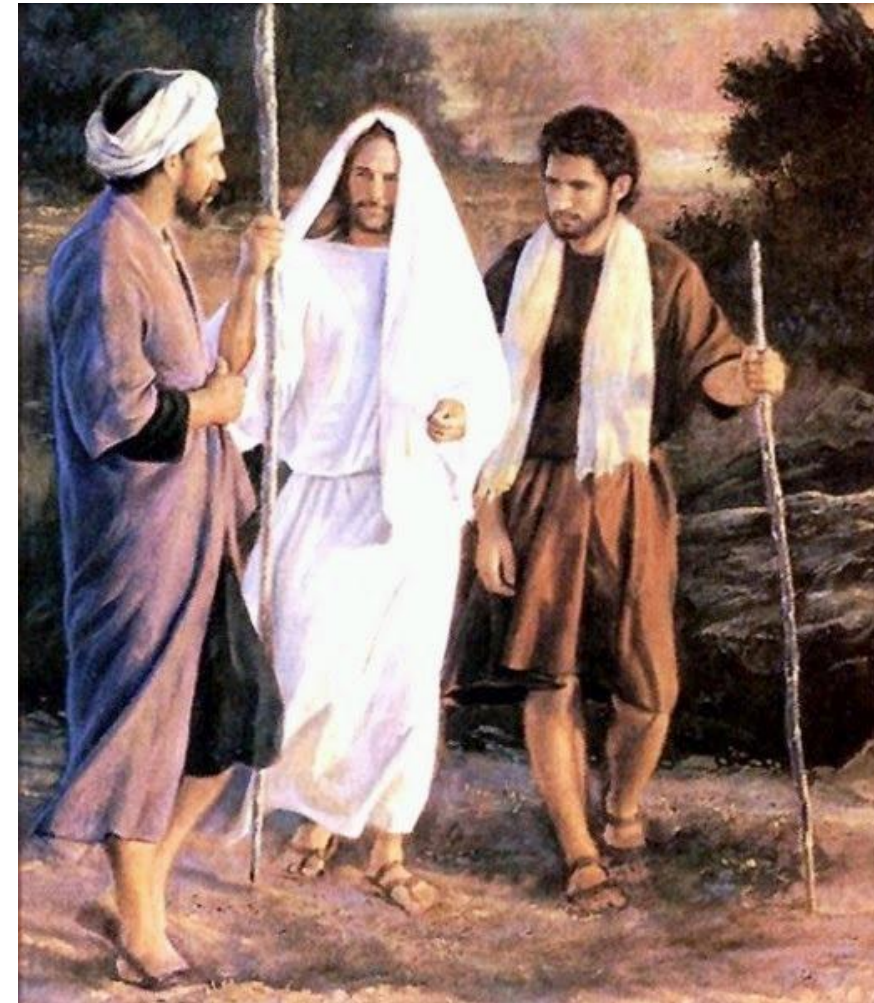
