+ First Saturday of the month devotion - Reparation Promise

In December 1940, Sister Lucy, a seer at Fatima, wrote to Pope Pius XII, that, in a revelation, our Lady asked that a Communion for the purpose of reparation on the First Saturday of five consecutive months be propagated throughout the world, and also confession (if necessary), meditation for a quarter of an hour on the mysteries of the Rosary, recitation of five decades of the Rosary, all for the purpose of reparation for the insults, sacrileges and indifferences committed against her Immaculate Heart.

According to Sister Lucy, our Lady promised to assist at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for salvation all those who would fulfil the aforementioned acts of reparation on the First Saturday of five consecutive months.
