* 2023 Collection for the Needs of the Church in Canada - September 23-24, 2023

The Collection for the Needs of the Church in Canada will take place on September 23 and 24. Each year, and with the generosity of Catholic faithful from coast to coast to coast, the Bishops of Canada continue their work on important doctrinal and ethical questions; ecumenical initiatives and interreligious dialogue; international relations; evangelization, faith education and catechesis; relations with Indigenous peoples; questions of social justice; and the development of a culture of life and family. In addition to their national Conference, the Bishops of Canada also meet in four Regional Assemblies (Atlantic, Quebec, Ontario and the West).

The main purpose of the collection is to help the bishops pay their annual diocesan dues to the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB), as well as any annual financial contribution to their regional episcopal assembly. In addition, any extra amounts collected can be used by the diocese for its own pastoral needs, although some bishops choose to give these extra amounts to the CCCB as a donation.

Let us not shy away from getting involved in the democratic process, and continue to advocate for the good of all. And foremost, let us pray for this upcoming election, for the various debates that will precede it, and

especially for those officials who will be elected to serve the common good. May the Lord bless and enlighten them and allow for greater justice and charity to spring forth in our society. If you would like a good starting point to inform your coming vote, the Catholic Conscience organisation has prepared a set of comprehensive online and printable voter resources for October's provincial election. These materials are intended to guide Catholics through a process of non-partisan, prayerful reflection while arming them with the materials they need to vote wisely. The documents touch upon several Catholic social teaching topics, such as the sanctity of human life from conception to natural death, stewardship of creation, family, community and the common good, an economy to serve people, civil rights and obligations, solidarity, and good government that aims for justice and peace. Nearly 3,000 people have been killed by the powerful earthquake (magnitude 6.8) that struck Morocco overnight on Friday, September 8. More than 5,500 people have been injured. There has been widespread

damage, with thousands of homes, 530 schools and many roads having been damaged or destroyed. Some 380,000 people have been directly affected and UNICEF estimates that about 100,000 children will need protection. Your donation will be used to provide shelter, food, clothing, hygiene kits and medical and psychosocial assistance. In the longer term, your donation will be used to help families regain their homes, rebuild their economic and social lives and exercise their democratic rights, so that Morocco can continue its fight against poverty.
