October 1, the feast of Saint Thérèse of Lisieux, patroness of missions, marked the beginning of Missionary Month. World Mission Day (WMD), the “summit” of Missionary Month, will be celebrated on **October 22** and will once again be an opportunity to support projects and initiatives in several of the approximately 1,100 poorest dioceses in the world which still depend on the Dicastery for Evangelization. Inspired by the story of the disciples of Emmaus, this year’s theme is: “Hearts on fire, feet on the move. » (cf. Luke 24, 13-35)
